This two-part dramatic story from the period of the collapse of the Austro-Hungarian Empire captures the key events leading up to the creation of an independent Czechoslovak state in October 1918. Its main protagonists are Alois Rasin and Karel Kramar, who have wrongly remained overshadowed by Tomas Garrigue Masaryk and Edvard Benes. Despite efforts to preserve the Austro-Hungarian monarchy or to take shelter under the wings of tsarist Russia, they managed to realise the long-time dream of Czechs and Slovaks for a shared republic.
